

Shelter Cook

SOJOURNER is a domestic violence program that supports those victimized by domestic violence and is located in the western suburban area of the Twin Cities. We are seeking individuals who enjoy cooking.

The Shelter Cook works with staff/volunteers to create a home-like and welcoming kitchen environment for residents. This position requires someone who enjoys cooking and being around people. Responsibilities include menu planning with shelter supervisor; helping to plan menus with Shelter Coordinator, cooking home-made or pre made meals for approximately 20 adults and children; and maintaining clean, safe kitchen in compliance with kitchen guidelines.

Essential Functions of the job.

- Maintains a clean, healthy and safe kitchen in compliance with health guidelines
- Works with the Shelter Coordinator to plan nutritious meals
- Baking (optional)
- Prepares dinner meal
- Works at times with cooking volunteers
